These functions include attention, listening, speech production, emotions, motor skills, memory, vision and decision making.

This workshop will help you to extend your creativity in using music at your work place. It will look at the concepts of music and help you to use music in a functional way to address developmental goals such as pre-verbal & verbal communication, social engagement skill, self-regulation and confidence.

The workshop will enable you to:

- Understand the basic concepts of music (including melody, rhythm, harmony and form) and how these can be used to address developmental goals
- Competently use 5 songs within your work setting
- Select suitable repertoire and to find resources and follow-up support.
